



CMEC DISCLOSURE POLICY

It is the policy of the Bridgeport Hospital Continuing Medical Education Committee to ensure balance, independence, objectivity and scientific rigor in its education programs. All faculty are required to complete documentation (provided by the respective department/section) which will disclose:

- relevant financial relationship(s) between the speaker and the commercial interest over the previous 12 months
- information having the potential to influence the content of CME regarding the products, devices or services of the commercial interest.

The Bridgeport Hospital Continuing Medical Education Committee has a process that will identify all conflicts of interest prior to an education program. Detailed disclosure information will be made available to the audience before the start of the activity. Participants will be expected to evaluate the program at its completion and answer several questions which will assist the program organizers including whether or not the program contained "conflict of interest or commercial bias".

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
